

How To Qualify For The Internationals

There are three (3) simple steps to qualify for the NAPA Internationals.

#1. Becoming Eligible

The first step in order for your players to qualify for the [NAPA Internationals](#) is to play matches in your local leagues. Once a player has played a minimum of five (5) matches in your local leagues the player becomes eligible to play on the NAPA Poolshooters Tour. The NAPA Poolshooters Tour is where they can qualify for the [NAPA Internationals](#).

NOTE: Once your players have their five (5) matches played, they must also maintain their five (5) matches played in the 1-year leading up to the event that they want to play in on the NAPA Poolshooters Tour.

FOR EXAMPLE: If you have a player that wants to play in a tour stop that begins on January 17th, they must have five (5) NAPA matches played in the 1-year leading up to January 17th.

#2. Enter a Tour Stop

Once becoming eligible to play at a NAPA Poolshooters Tour event your players simply need to find an event they would like to attend and sign up. All events can be found on our website (<https://poolshooters.com>) under the **Upcoming Events** section. When they find an event they want to play in they can simply click on the details of the event and sign up.

Remember, the tour season is January 1st through September 30th. October 1st through December 31st is our Championship season and the Upcoming Events section on our website during this time will only show our championship events. Tour dates for the upcoming tour year will start showing up on the website around end of November.

#3. Win One Match and Qualify

1. All participants who win at least one match in the "Open" 8-ball tournament of a tour stop qualify for the annual NAPA International "Open" 8-ball Championships. In short...don't go "two and out".
2. All participants who win at least one match in the "Open" 9-ball tournament of a tour stop qualify for the annual NAPA International "Open" 9-ball Championships. In short...don't go "two and out".
3. All participants who win at least one match in the "Open" 10-ball tournament of a tour stop qualify for the annual NAPA International "Open" 10-ball Championships. In short...don't go "two and out".
4. All participants who win at least one match in the "Ladies" 8-ball tournament of a tour stop qualify for the annual NAPA International "Ladies" 8-ball Championships. In short...don't go "two and out".
5. All participants who win at least one match in the "Ladies" 9-ball tournament of a tour stop qualify for the annual NAPA International "Ladies" 9-ball Championships. In short...don't go "two and out".
